With photography, a privacy policy should be common sense and common courtesy. We treat your personal information the way we would want our personal information treated -- with respect.

What This Privacy Policy Covers

This privacy policy covers how RaidenShine Photography treats personal information that we collect and receive, including information related to your use of our services. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.

Information Collection and Use

We may combine information about you that we have with information we obtain from business partners or other companies, however we will not redistribute any list that contains information we have received from you.

We may request information about your address, occupation, industry, etc. We use information for the following general purposes: To fulfill your requests for products and services; To improve our services; To contact you.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

We do not rent, sell, or share personal information about you with other people or nonaffiliated companies except to provide products or services you've requested, when we have your permission, or under the following circumstances: We respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims; We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, or as otherwise required by law. We transfer information about you if RaidenShine Photography is acquired by or merged with another company. In this event, We will notify you before information about you is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

Confidentiality and Security

We limit access to personal information about you to employees who we believe reasonably need to come into contact with that information to provide products or services to you or in order to do their jobs. We have physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect personal information about you.
